For example, fans of Napoleon start with the exhibition "Josephine" at the Musée du Luxembourg, then take a historian-guided tour through the sites most relevant to Napoleon's Paris, many closed to the public, culminating at the [Château de Fontainebleau](#), where the Emperor bid farewell to the nation. "When people are moved by what they've seen, I feel I've done my job," Pochna says.
